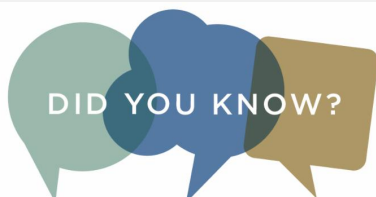


## Time to Register

## St. Catherine Ghana Mission Project Dinner and Dancing

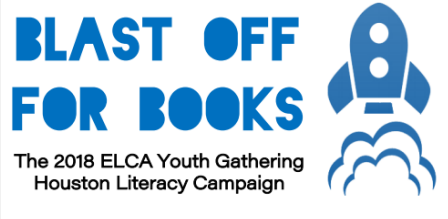
